## THE TRADE UNIONS LAW, 1949.

## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 29 (h).

It is hereby notified that, in exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (h) of section 29 of the Trade Unions Law, 1949, and of every other power thereunto enabling, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to declare the objects set out in the Schedule hereto to be additional objects for which the funds of a trade union may, subject to its rules and to the provisions of section 30 of the said Law, be expended.

2. This notification shall come into force on the 31st day of March, 1949.

## Schedule.

1. Affiliation fees or other contributions to any lawful Federation of two or more trade unions or any body of persons established for the co-ordination of the activities of any trade union or branch thereof, as prescribed in the rules of such body.

2. Affiliation fees or other contributions to a charitable, educational or cultural institution or society approved by the Registrar.

3. Contributions to any registered trade union for the purpose of assisting such trade union in financial difficulties.

4. Legal advice for the purpose of securing or protecting any rights of the trade union as such or any rights arising out of the relations of any member with his employer or with a person whom the member employs, or any rights of any member or his dependants arising out of a civil cause.

5. Allowance to members in distress through circumstances beyond their control.

6. Social insurance, medical aid, and the supply of medicaments and drugs to members or their dependants, and any incidental expenses thereof.

7. Educational, cultural and vocational training of members as approved by the Registrar and any incidental expenses thereof.

8. The organization of any theatrical performance, concert, reception, dance, sport meeting or excursion.

9. Purchase of books, newspapers and other literature and the upkeep of a reading room for the use of members.

10. Edition, printing, publication and circulation of any book, newspaper or other periodical, bulletin, pamphlet or other printed literature for the advancement of the objects of a trade union as specified in this Law or the promotion of the interest of its members as such.

11. Expenses incurred on trade union business by the electedrepresentatives of workmen in a workplace.

12. Interest on loans, Income and other legally imposed taxes.

13. With the special approval of the Governor previously obtained, purchase or lease of land exceeding three donums in extent
