(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER
DEFENCE REGULATION 61.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Avgorou, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF AVGOROU
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them under section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Avgorou hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Avgorou) (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Avgorou) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Avgorou) Rules, 1938 and 1949.

2. The following rules shall be substituted for rules 20 and 46, respectively, of the principal Rules :—

"Rule 20. The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner of, or the person slaughtering, any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say :—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox	...	6
(b) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	...	3
(c) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight	...	2
(d) for every swine above 30 okes carcass weight	...	6
(e) for every swine of 30 okes or under carcass weight	...	3

Rule 46. The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

(b) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	—	3

THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 AND 1944.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Exometokhi No. 2, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF EXOMETOKHI NO. 2.

Rules.

These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Exometokhi No. 2 (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Exometokhi No. 2 Rules, 1945 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Exometokhi No. 2 Rules, 1945 and 1949.

2. Rule 4(3) of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “the treasurer shall be unpaid” and the substitution therefor of the words “the treasurer shall receive a remuneration of 5% of all the rates and charges collected by him, as provided in section 4(1) of this rule.” (M.P. 701/45.)

THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 TO 1949.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 to 1949, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Kouris River, in the District of Limassol, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF KOURIS RIVER.

Rules.

These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Kouris River (Amendment) Rules, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Kouris River Rules, 1945 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Kouris River Rules, 1945 and 1949.

2. Paragraph (3) of rule 4 of the principal Rules is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor :—

“(3) The treasurer shall be paid—

- (a) a remuneration of five per centum on all rates and charges collected by him as in paragraph (1) hereof;
- (b) such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee.”
