

No. 11.**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purpose of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Raisins Control) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall be read together with the Supplies and Services (Raisins Control) Order, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Supplies and Services (Raisins Control) Orders, 1949 and 1950.

2. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "twenty" (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the word "fifty".

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of clause 7 and the substitution therefor of the following clause:—

"7. No person other than an authorized purchaser or the holder of a permit shall after the 28th February, 1950, have in his possession or under his control any quantity of raisins in excess of 50 okes".

No. 13.**THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.**
