THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2411

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Lysi (Famagusta District) to utilize an authorized loan for different purposes.

Whereas by an Order in Council No. 2377 of the 24th August, 1949, (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") published under Notification No. 354 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 22nd September, 1949, the Governor in Council gave authority to the Village Health Commission of Lysi (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission"), to contract a loan of two thousand pounds (£2,000) (hereinafter referred to as "the loan"), to be utilized for reconditioning the streets within the said village;

And whereas it is now desirable to spend up to one hundred and forty pounds (£140) out of the said loan for repairs to certain works which protect the said village and its streets against floods;

And whereas in this respect the Commission has now applied for authority so to do under section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order that the Order be amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (b) of clause 1 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—

"(b) That out of the sum to be borrowed, not more than one hundred and forty pounds (£140) shall be utilized by the Commission for repairs to certain works which protect the village and its streets against floods, and the balance shall be utilized for reconditioning the streets within the village."

No. 162. THE INTERPRETATION LAW, 1935.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 22.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 22 of the Interpretation Law, 1935, I, the Governor, do hereby depute the Commissioner of Limassol for the time being to exercise on my behalf all the powers which I am empowered to exercise under the provisions of section 14 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, in connection with betterment contribution from persons whose property has increased in value as a result of the construction of the road known as the Limassol Bypass, the acquisition of which was sanctioned under Notification No. 200 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th May, 1949.
