THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1949.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1949, and on the report of the Director of Education, I, the Governor, do hereby order that the Committee of Management for the Maronite Schools shall repair and improve the school premises in the village of Kormakiti (Kyrenia), and extend the school building in the village of Ayia Marina (Skyloura), Nicosia.

THE ELECTRICITY LAW, 1940.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 4 of the Electricity Law, 1940, duly delegated to the Colonial Secretary by Notification No. 314 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 18th October, 1945, I, the Acting Colonial Secretary, do hereby grant an Order authorizing James Owen Hall, O.B.E., Chief Engineer, Central Electrification Scheme, Cyprus, to generate and supply electricity for private purposes within the Area of Supply set out in the First Schedule hereto for a period ending the 31st December, 1951, and to undertake all works necessary for—

- (a) the construction of a generating station situated at Dhekelia, and
- (b) the construction of a 66,000 volt overhead and underground transmission system, transforming stations and 11,000 volt overhead and underground secondary distribution systems throughout the Island.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The area in the Xylymbou Minor Forest authorized by the Commissioner of Larnaca for the location of the Dhekelia Power Station Staff Quarters.

2. The area at Dhekelia acquired for the construction of a power station and all associated structures.
