No. 189. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LEFKA.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lefka hereby make the following bye-laws:—

I. These bye-laws may be cited as the Lefka Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Lefka Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Lefka Municipal Bye-laws, 1940 to 1950.

2. Bye-law 35 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the following bye-law substituted therefor:—

- "35. The following fees shall be paid to the inspector by the person in charge of any animal brought to the animal market:—
 - (a) For every ass, camel, horse, mule or ox

 Provided that the young ones of the above named up to
 12 months old, if running loose with their mothers, shall be
 admitted free of charge into the animal market.
 - (b) For every goat or sheep $4\frac{1}{2}p$. (c) For every kid or lamb under three months 3p."
