**THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1950.**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2415**

**MADE UNDER SECTION 116 (a) (i).**

*Authority to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lefkoniko  
to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 116 (a) (i) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1950, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Lefkoniko (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Lefkoniko Co-operative Credit Society (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of four thousand pounds (£4,000) at a rate of interest not exceeding three per centum (3%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the Lender in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest), the first instalment to become due and payable one year after the date of contracting the loan, and all subsequent instalments being payable on the corresponding date in each year following until final repayment:

Provided that failure to pay any instalment as hereinbefore provided shall render due and payable the whole amount of the loan then due and owing;

- (b) the Municipal Corporation shall, in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the sums payable as aforesaid in the year to which such estimates relate;
- (c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized for the purpose of providing street lighting by electricity and means of distributing electric current within the municipal limits of Lefkoniko;
- (d) tenders shall be invited for the supply of all equipment and materials required in connection therewith, the detailed specifications of the items of equipment or materials to be ordered shall be agreed to

by the Director of Public Works and tenders shall be accepted only with the approval of the Director of Public Works ;

- (e) tenders shall be invited for the execution of the works connected with the scheme and tenders shall be accepted only with the approval of the Director of Public Works :

Provided that the Municipal Corporation shall employ a qualified Consulting Engineer in connection with the execution of such works.

2. That, for the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized, subject to any prior encumbrances thereon to mortgage to the Lender all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.

THE BANKING (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) LAWS, 1939.  
(1946)

APPOINTMENT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 3 (1).
