THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW, 1948.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, 1948, I hereby direct that during the period between 1st July, 1950, and 30th November, 1950, flocks within the area of Akanthou village in the District of Famagusta shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure :

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1950. α. 52/221

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF ATHIENOU.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1950, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Athienou hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Athienou Municipal Corporation (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Athienou Municipal Corporation Bye-laws, 1948 and 1949, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Athienou Municipal Corporation Bye-laws, 1948 to 1950.

2. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 39 of the following bye-law :—

" 39A. The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner or the person in charge of any meat brought into or exposed for sale in the Meat Market :—

(a) for every ox or cow of any age—	s.	p.
(i) if not exceeding 35 okes in weight	1	0
(ii) if 35 okes and over but not exceeding 60 okes in weight	1	4½
(iii) if 60 okes and over but not exceeding 100 okes in weight	2	0
(iv) if 100 okes and over in weight	3	0
(b) for every sheep or goat of any age—		
(i) if 6 okes in weight or less	—	1
(ii) if 6 okes and over but not exceeding 12 okes in weight	—	2
(iii) if 12 okes and over in weight	—	3"

3. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 41 of the following bye-law :—

“ 41A. The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the person exposing for sale any carcass of a pig or fresh pork :—

for every carcass of a pig or part thereof or portion of fresh pork—	s.	p.
(a) not exceeding 40 okes in weight	3	0
(b) exceeding 40 okes but not exceeding 60 okes in weight ..	4	0
(c) exceeding 60 okes but not exceeding 100 okes in weight ..	5	0
(d) exceeding 100 okes in weight	6	0

THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 TO 1949.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 to 1949, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Panayia, in the District of Paphos, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF PANAYIA.

2. Paragraph (3) of rule 4 of the principal Rules is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor :—

“(3) The treasurer shall be paid—

- (a) a remuneration of five per centum of all rates and charges collected by him ;
- (b) such of his out of pocket expenses as may be sanctioned by the Committee.”

No. 220. THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES LAW, 1948.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE WATER COMMISSION OF KALAVASOS UNDER SECTION 29.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 29 of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, 1948, the Water Commission of Kalavasos village hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Village Domestic Water Supply (Kalavasos) Bye-Laws, 1950.

2. In those bye-laws, unless the context otherwise requires—

“ Commissioner ” means the Commissioner of the District of Larnaca and includes an Assistant Commissioner of that District ;

“ Law ” means the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, 1948, and any law amending or substituted for the same ;

“ Village ” means the village of Kalavasos ;

“ Water ” means the water of the water supply ;

“ Water Commission ” means the Water Commission of Kalavasos village ;

“ Water supply ” means the supply of water for domestic purposes used or constructed under the Law in the village of Kalavasos and includes all wells, bores, reservoirs, dams, weirs, tanks, cisterns, tunnels, filterbeds, conduits, aqueducts, mains, pipes, fountains, sluices, valves, pumps, channels, engines and other structures or appliances used or constructed for the storage, conveyance, supply, distribution, measurement or regulation of the water of such supply of water.
