No. 269. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 1.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, and delegated to me by Notification No. 172 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I, Ivan Lloyd Phillips, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia Districts, do hereby order that a new burial ground shall be provided, under the provisions of the said Laws, for use by the Christian community of the village of Kharcha, in the District of Kyrenia, in lieu of the burial ground now in use by the said community.
