A PROCLAMATION.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Governor.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Kato Lakatamia and Ayii Trimithias, in the District of Nicosia.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, Andrew Barkworth Wright, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross and Bar, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st September, 1950, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Kato Lakatamia, in the District of Nicosia, shall form part of the lands of the village of Ayii Trimithias, in the District of Nicosia, and that the boundaries of the villages of Kato Lakatamia and Ayii Trimithias shall be altered accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

Area to be transferred from Kato Lakatamia village to Ayii Trimithias village.

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 282 of "Block D" of Kato Lakatamia village, locality "Petalies", which point is on the boundary between the villages of Kato Lakatamia and Pano Dheftera and proceeds eastwards along the said boundary to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 65 of "Block B" of Pano Dheftera village; thence eastwards and south-eastwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 273 and 276 of "Block D" of Kato Lakatamia village to their junction with the boundary between the villages of Kato Lakatamia and Pano Dheftera; thence westwards and northwards along the said village boundary to the point of commencement, the boundary of all which said area is shown edged in red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1477.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Troodos, this 26th day of July, 1950.
