

3. Clause 10 of the principal order is hereby deleted and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“ 10. Every person shall permit such person as the Vine Products Controller or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises and take such steps, including the sealing of any apparatus used or which may be used for producing zivania, as will be found necessary to ensure that the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.”

4. Clause 11 (d) of the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion in the second line immediately after the word “ duties ” of the following:—

“ or removes, breaks or in any way interferes with, any seals affixed on any zivania producing apparatus.”

THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) (Amendment No. 2) Bye-laws, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1949 (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Bye-laws ”) and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1949.

2. Bye-laws 34, 47 and 75 of the principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the deletion of the words “ except on Sundays when it shall be closed at 2 p.m. ”, wherever they appear in the said bye-laws, and the substitution therefor of the words “ except on Sundays when it shall be closed during the whole day and on such other day of the week to be fixed by the Council when it shall be closed at 2 p.m. ”.

3. Bye-law 62 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the following bye-law substituted therefor :—

“ 62. The shops, stalls and places situated in the Municipal Market, which are now used for the sale of fresh fish, are hereby provided and shall henceforth be used as a public fish market.”

4. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 67 of the following bye-law :—

“ 67A. The shops, stalls and places situated in the fish market may be let on hire by the Council for such period and on such terms and conditions as the Council may from time to time determine :

Provided there are other shops, stalls or places therein for the sale of fresh fish by persons other than lessees.”

5. Bye-law 68 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the addition thereto after paragraph (2) of the following paragraph :—

“ (3) The tolls in paragraph (1) of this bye-law prescribed, shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh fish in the fish market, who is a monthly or yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the fish market under bye-law 67A of these bye-laws.”

6. Bye-laws 3, 4 and 5 of these bye-laws shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 9th day of August, 1949.

7. Paragraph (1) of bye-law 168A of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after the words “ St. Andrew Street and Themis Street ” in the seventeenth line thereof of the following :—

“ ‘ Kanaris Street ’.—The direction leading to Hellas Street, along the portion of the street which is between Kitiou Kyprianou Street and Ptolemeon Street.”

8. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 168B of the following Part and bye-laws :—

“ PART XIII B.

MUNICIPAL GARDEN.

168AA.—No person shall, without the consent or authority of the mayor previously obtained, within the limits of the Municipal Garden of Limassol—

- (a) lead, ride, drive or take any animal, bicycle, tricycle or vehicle, provided that the prohibitions contained in this paragraph (a) shall not apply to bicycles or tricycles pushed by pedestrians ;
- (b) play in any place of such Municipal Garden not specially reserved by the Council for play ;
- (c) enter any place of such Municipal Garden the entrance to which is prohibited by the Council or the mayor ;
- (d) cut, destroy, damage or injure or cause or allow or suffer to be cut, destroyed, damaged or injured any plants, trees, flowers, hedges, buildings, benches or other parts of such Municipal Garden or other property of the Municipal Corporation.”

The above Bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Governor. (M.P. 1903/49.)
