

No. 32. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) (Amendment No. 3) Bye-laws, 1949, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to (No. 3) 1949.

2. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the following Schedule:—

**"SECOND SCHEDULE.
(Bye-law 161B).**

ENTERTAINMENT DUTY.

	<i>Rates.</i>
(i) On each ticket the total price of which does not exceed 6p.	<i>p.</i> 1
(ii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 6p. but does not exceed 1s.	2
(iii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 1s. but does not exceed 2s.	4
(iv) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 2s. but does not exceed 3s.	6
(v) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 3s. but does not exceed 10s.: on each shilling or part thereof of such price	2
(vi) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 10s.: on each shilling or part thereof of such price	3"

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF PAPHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos hereby make the following bye-laws:—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1950.

2. Items 22 and 23 of the Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1948) are hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—
