No. 324. THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAWS, 1938 AND 1946.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 29.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Whereas the Summer Resort Development Board of Kakopetria in the District of Nicosia has decided by unanimous resolution that the land (house and yard, and field with trees) situated in Kakopetria, particulars whereof are set out in the Schedule hereto, should be acquired for the erection of a public market;

And whereas such land could not be acquired or bought by agreement between the owners thereof and the Board;

And whereas a copy of the resolution and of the minutes relating to it, together with a plan of the land to be acquired, was forwarded by the aforementioned Board to the Commissioner of Nicosia;
