THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW, 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Onions) Export (Amendment) Regulations, 1050, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce (Onions) Export Regulations, 1950 Gazette: (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Suppl. No. 3: Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Agri. 16.3.1950 cultural Produce (Onions) Export Regulations, 1950

2. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended—
(a) by the substitution at the end of paragraph (c) of a colon for the full stop (line 6);

(b) by the addition at the end thereof (after paragraph (c)), of the following proviso:—

"Provided that, in such cases as the Director of Agriculture may think fit, onions packed in cases or bags which are not in conformity with the requirements of paragraph (a) of this regulation may be passed as fit for export if such cases or bags are approved by him."
