

2. Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended—  
 (a) by the substitution at the end of paragraph (c) of a colon for the full stop (line 6);  
 (b) by the addition at the end thereof (after paragraph (c)), of the following proviso:—

“ Provided that, in such cases as the Director of Agriculture may think fit, onions packed in cases or bags which are not in conformity with the requirements of paragraph (a) of this regulation may be passed as fit for export if such cases or bags are approved by him.”
