THE CAROB WEIGHING AND SHIPPING PLACE IMPROVEMENT LAWS, 1914 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2434 MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 3 of the Carob Weighing and Shipping Place Improvement Laws, 1914 to 1948, and of every other power thereunto enabling, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, does hereby revoke the Order in Council No. 669 published in the *Gazette* of the 11th August, 1916, under Notification No. 377 (by which the Evdhimou-Pissouri Carob Shipping Place, in the District of Limassol, was declared to be a carob shipping place for the purposes of the said Laws).

CIVIL AVIATION ACT, 1949.

AIR NAVIGATION ORDER, 1949.

The Minister of Civil Aviation pursuant to Article 64 of the Air Navigation Order, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Air Transport Licensing Authority in the Colony of Cyprus, to exercise in the said Colony the powers of the Minister under the Order which are hereinafter specified, that is to say:—

Until the thirtieth day of September, 1950, to grant to the holder of a licence issued under the Air Navigation (Consolidation) Order, 1923, entitling him to act as a pilot of a public transport or aerial work aircraft, a licence under Article 20 of the Order entitling him to act in a corresponding capacity:

upon his being satisfied, having regard to any appropriate requirements contained in the Order or in the Air Navigation (General) Regulations, 1949, that any such powers as aforesaid should in a particular case be exercised.
