A PROCLAMATION.

O. R. ARTHUR,

Governor's Deputy.

Whereas it is expedient that the village of Ayios Merkourios, in the District of Paphos, should be abolished:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling him in that behalf, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby proclaim that the village of Ayios Merkourios in the District of Paphos be, for all administrative purposes, abolished as from the 1st day of November, 1950, and that the whole of the present area of the said village be transferred to Lyso village in the District of Paphos and form one common area of the said village of Lyso as from the said date.

No. 419. THE GOATS (FREE RANGING) TAX LAW, 1948.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 5.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 5 of the Goats (Free Ranging) Tax Law, 1948, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby order that the tax payable by the owner in respect of every free ranging goat belonging to him and enumerated under the Sheep, Goats and Pigs (Enumeration) Law, 1948, shall be paid on the 1st January, 1951.
