

No. 420. THE BAKERIES (NIGHT WORK) LAW, 1950.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 4.

O. R. ARTHUR,

Whereas I am satisfied that in the circumstances prevailing at Amiandos it is desirable that special provision for work at night in the bakery of the Cyprus Asbestos Mines Limited, at Amiandos, should be made:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 4 of the Bakeries (Night Work) Law, 1950, I, the Governor's Deputy, do hereby order that the restrictions imposed by the Bakeries (Night Work) Law, 1950, shall not apply to the bakery at Amiandos of the Cyprus Asbestos Mines Limited, so long as:—

- (a) persons employed in a nightshift shall not work for more than eight consecutive hours and shall have a break for meal each night;
- (b) a rotation system of one nightshift and two dayshifts shall be worked each extending over one week so as to ensure that no person shall be employed for more than six, or seven if a seven-day week is worked, consecutive nights in every three weeks.

This Order shall expire on the 31st day of December, 1950.
