SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 42. THE GOVERNMENT LANDS LAW, 1941.

GRANT MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 2.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Government Lands Law, 1941, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order that the Schedule to the Notification No. 399 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 12th December, 1946 (relating to the grant of certain plots of land in Ayios Ioannis Quarter in the town of Nicosia) be amended by the deletion from the first column (under title "Name of Grantee") of the name "Panayota Chr. Nathanael" (item 9) and the substitution therefor of the name "Stylianos Haji Iona" who is hereby constituted as the Grantee of the land appearing against item 9, in lieu of the Grantee now therein appearing, subject to the same conditions as in the said Notification contained, except that the said new Grantee shall not be required to pay the amount appearing in the last column of the said Schedule.

No. 43. THE COLONIAL AIR NAVIGATION ORDER, 1949.

REGULATIONS UNDER ARTICLES 49 (1) AND 64.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Articles 49 (1) and 64 of the Colonial Air Navigation Order, 1949, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Aerodrome Charges) (Amendment) Regulations, 1950, and shall be read as one with

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the Air Navigation (Aerodrome Charges) Regulations, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Air Navigation (Aerodrome Charges) Regulations, 1948 and 1950.

2. Paragraph (a) of regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "other than transport aircraft".

No. 44. THE PRISON DISCIPLINE LAW, 1879.
