And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia by Notice published under No. 374 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th September, 1950, gave particulars of the lands required in connection with the Notification as aforesaid;

And whereas in compliance with the aforesaid Laws the Commissioner forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations and plans or particulars, together with the objections made;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plans and particulars submitted and considers it expedient having regard to all the circumstances of the case that the lands in question be acquired;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, the Governor does hereby sanction the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated in the village of Strovolos particulars whereof are specifically set out in the Notice of the Commissioner of Nicosia under No. 374 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th September, 1950.
