**THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.**

**NOTIFICATION MADE UNDER SECTION 17.**

*Pyla (Larnaca) Fund.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Tree Planting (Village Areas) Law, 1948, I hereby establish a Fund for the village of Pyla, in the District of Larnaca (hereinafter called "the Fund"), into which shall be paid all fines recovered under the said Law for offences committed within the Tree Planting Area of the village of Pyla as described in the Order made the 16th day of July, 1944, and published under Notification No. 249 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 3127 of the 20th July, 1944.

The Fund shall be under the management and control of the Commissioner of Larnaca for the time being.

The money in the Fund shall be utilized for works of public utility within the village of Pyla.
