

No. 472. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5.**

With reference to the Notification published under No. 438 in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 3523 of 18th October, 1950, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertakings of public utility mentioned therein :—

1. All that area of land with the buildings thereon situated in Spyros Araouzos Street, Ayia Napa Quarter, in the town of Limassol, comprising 2 evleks and 1,280 sq. ft. or thereabouts and including plots Nos. 319, 320, 321, 322, 323, 324, 325, 326, 327, 328 and 329 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIX.2.2.Π, Block V, more particularly defined as the area hatched in yellow on the plan numbered as blue 63 in the file of the Commissioner of Limassol No. 290/49.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands is required within six weeks from the date of the publication of this notice in the *Gazette* to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. The plan showing the land described above is available for inspection at my office at Limassol.
