## THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW, 1934.

Notice under Section 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, 1934, I do hereby absolutely prohibit-

(a)—(i) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, nightsoil or any other refuse from any pier, wharf, quay or jetty, situated within the District of Famagusta;

(ii) the dumping of any rybble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the areas of the foreshore described in the Schedule here to;

(iii) the dumping of My rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse into the sea at any point opposite to the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto within a distance of 200 yards from low water mark.

(b) Save under a permit from me previously obtained, prohibit the removal of any stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from any part of that area of foreshore described in the Schedule

2. Any previous notices issued by the Commissioner of Famagusta published in the Gazette under the said Law are hereby cancelled.

## SCHEDULE.

The foreshore commences at a point situated at the junction of the foreshore with the southest face of Boghaz jetty near Government plot 322, sheet 25, plan 28. E. II and thence follows the line along the coast in a south-westerly direction to a point-situated on the southern side of the Kharanka River near the Trikomo-Spathariko boundary, sheet 24, plan 3.W, and extends to a depth of 50 yards from high water mark throughout its

2. The foreshore commences at a point situated to the eastern side of Livadhia field, plot 24 (belonging to Maria Symeou of Lapathos), sheet 24. plan 11.W and situated to the north of the Spathariko-Ayios Servios boundary and thence follows the line along the coast in a general southerly direction to a point on the southern boundary of plot 29 (belonging to Panayiotis Stavrou Kteniari), sheet 24, plan 19.W in the locality known as "Sheromillia", and extends to a depth of 50 yards from high water mark throughout its length.

3. The foreshore commences at the north boundary of field 151 (belonging to Hambis Haji Philippou), sheet 24, plan 26.E at the locality known as "Louman", and thence follows the line along the coast in a general south and south-easterly direction to a point situated to the southern side of field 67, sheet 24, plan 35.W near the Salamis Forest, and extends to a depth of 50 yards from high water mark throughout its length.

4. The foreshore commences at a point situated at the junction of the foreshore with the south face of the main jetty in Famagusta Harbour and thence follows the line along the coast in a general southerly and southeasterly direction to a point situated to the eastern boundary of plot 47 (belotiging to Paraskevas D. Lordos), sheet 33, plan 13.4 IV and extends to a

depth of 50 yards from high water mark throughout its length.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Kolossi, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the Gazette.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF KOLOSSI UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Kolossi hereby make the following rules:-

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Kolossi) Gazette: (Amendment) Rules, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Village Suppl. No. 3: Health (Kolossi) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal 22. 7.1938 Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Kolossi) Rules, 1938 and 1950.

2. The following rules shall be substituted for rules 20 and 46,

respectively, of the principal Rules:-

"Rule 20. The following fees shall be paid by the owner of or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house, that is to say :p.

3 (a) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep 6 (b) For every swine ...

(c) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox ...... - 6

Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:-

(a) For every carcass of sheep, goat, kid or lamb or part thereof ...

(b). For every carcass of swine, camel, bullock, cow or ox or part thereof ...

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule prescribed shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these rules."

3. The following Chapter shall be added to the principal Rules:—

"Chapter 1.—Market of Perishable Goods.

26. The Village Health Commission may from time to time by public notification appoint any premises or place within the area of the village to be the market of perishable goods,
