**THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES
LAW, 1948.**

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, 1948, I, Ivan Lloyd Phillips, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia Districts, do hereby declare that the village of Sha shall be a village to which the provisions of the said Law shall apply.

**THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND
CONTROL) LAW, 1948.**

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, 1948, I hereby direct that during the period between the 23rd November, 1950, and the 15th June, 1951, flocks within the area of the villages of Pano and Kato Polemidhia shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.
