No. 493. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 3) 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2446

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 65 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948, I, the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows —

1. This Order may be cited as the Wharfrage Dues for Imports (Aviation Oils and Fuels) Exemption Order, 1950.

2. All aviation lubricating oils and fuels which shall, after importation, be deposited in a licensed warehouse and which are proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller to have been issued directly therefrom to, and solely for use in, aircraft, shall be exempted from the payment of any wharfrage dues for imports.

No. 494. THE SHOP ASSISTANTS LAWS, 1942 AND 1945.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2447
MADE UNDER SECTION 19.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Shop Assistants Laws, 1942 and 1945, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Assistants (Pharmacies) Order, 1950.

2. Item 6 of the First and Second Schedule to the Shop Assistants Laws, 1942 and 1945, shall be read and construed subject to the provisions of this Order.

3. The premises of any pharmacist licensed under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Law, 1945, which, under any Notice in force for the time being issued under regulation 20 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations, 1946, are required not to open and be kept open during the time therein specified, shall be closed during the days and time specified in such Notice.

**THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES
LAW, 1948.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 12 (4).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 (4) of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, 1948, and with reference to the notice of the Commissioner of Famagusta dated the 26th June, 1950, published under Notification No. 263 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 13th July, 1950, relating to three springs of running water (hereinafter referred to as "the property"), under Sheet VII, Plan 24W, Plots 85, 2/1, 2/2 and 66/2 and 400 square feet of land from each of these plots round and near the aforesaid springs in the vicinity of Ephtakomi, in the District of Famagusta, I, the Governor, having approved the plan submitted and considering it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the Village Water Commission of Galatia should be permitted to acquire the property, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the said Law.
