THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2450 MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Prastio, Famagusta District, to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 94 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. The Village Health Commission of Prastio, Famagusta District, (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of one thousand nine hundred pounds (£1,900) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Commission to the Lender in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking

fund and interest);

(b) the Commission shall, in each year and until final repayment of the amount borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate;

(c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Commission for the

purpose of improving the streets within the village.

2. For the purposes of securing the repayment of the sum due under the loan the Commission is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all fees, charges and rates now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Commission under the provisions of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948.

THE FOREST LAWS, 1939 AND 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2451 MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Forest Laws, 1939 and 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) Orders, 1942 to 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Minor State Forests (Nicosia, Kyrenia and Paphos) Orders, 1942 to 1950.
- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—
 (a) By the deletion therefrom of the areas Nos. 1, 3, 10 and 27 (relating to the villages of Lymbia, Ayia Varvara, Dhali and Ayious Trimithias respectively) and the substitution therefor of the following areas:—

1. Lymbia in the District of Nicosia:

(a) A portion of the crown land under plots Nos. 166, 166/1 and 166/2 of Sheet XL, plans Nos. 9 and 10 at the localities "Stalos", "Merika" and "Laxies" demarcated by boundary marks numbered consecutively from 1 to 45 inclusive, comprising 64 donums and 2 evleks approximately but excluding plots Nos. 163 and 164 which are privately owned as shown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1452, delineated thereon in green and marked "A".

(b) A portion of the crown land under plot No. 453/1 of Sheet XL, plan 10 at the locality "Stavros" demarcated by boundary marks numbered consecutively from 1 to 20 inclusive, comprising 59 donums approximately but excluding plot No. 454 as privately owned and shown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1452, delineated thereon in

green and marked "B".

3. Dhali in the District of Nicosia:

A portion of the crown land under plots 418, 419, 420, 421, 426/2, 427, 428, 480/1, 480/2, 490 and 494 of Sheet XL, plan 1, localities "Kaminia", "Aloupotrypes" demarcated by boundary stones numbered con-
