THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2398

MADE UNDER SECTION 79 (1).

Whereas a complaint was made to the Governor that the Council of the municipal corporation of Limassol has made default in the performance of the duty, imposed on the said Council by section 115 (1) (y) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, that is to say, the duty of affixing the names of "Vassilios Macedon" and "Sir Herbert Richmond Palmer" in a conspicuous place in the respective streets, so named by a previous Council of the said corporation with the approval of the Governor;

And whereas the Governor in Council has after due enquiry been satisfied that the said Council has been guilty of the aforesaid default:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 79 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order the Council of the municipal corporation of Limassol to perform, within one month from the date of this Order, its duty of affixing the names of "Vassilios Macedon" and "Sir Herbert Richmond Palmer" in a conspicuous place in the respective streets, so named by a previous Council of the said corporation with the approval of the Governor.

No. 53. THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAW, 1949.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 9 (3).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9 (3) of the Aliens and Immigration Law, 1949, I, the Governor, do by this Order direct that British consular visas be dispensed with in the case of personnel required for search, rescue, investigation, repair or salvage in connection with lost or damaged aircraft, provided that such personnel are properly accredited by the State of registry of the lost or damaged aircraft in question.
