**THE PROPERTY OF HIS MAJESTY (THEFT AND POSSESSION)**  
**LAWS, 1946 TO 1948.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) (Continuance) Order, 1950.
2. The Property of His Majesty (Theft and Possession) Laws, 1946 to 1948, shall continue in operation until the 31st day of December, 1951.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st January, 1951.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 (2) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1950, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) Orders, 1947 to 1949, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) Orders, 1947 to 1950.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the insertion therein in the proper alphabetical order of the word "Livadhia-Kellia" in column 2 under the heading "Larnaca District" in respect of the Greek-Orthodox religious community;
- (b) by the insertion therein in the proper alphabetical order of the word "Asomatos-Phasouri Chiftlik", (the residential quarter of Phasouri Chiftlik falling within the limits of Akrotiri village), in column 2 under the heading "Limassol District" in respect of the Greek-Orthodox religious community;

No. 537. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, on the representation of the Postmaster-General, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Registration of Postal Packets) (Amendment) Regulations, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Registration of Postal Packets) Regulations, 1942 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Post Office (Registration of Postal Packets) Regulations, 1942 and 1950.

2. Regulation 14 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(a) by the deletion from paragraph (1) thereof of the amount "£2" (line 4), and the substitution therefor of the amount "£2. 18s. 0p.";
