No. 537. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, on the representation of the Postmaster-General, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Registration of Postal Packets) (Amendment) Regulations, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Registration of Postal Packets) Regulations, 1942 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Post Office (Registration of Postal Packets) Regulations, 1942 and 1950.

2. Regulation 14 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended—

(a) by the deletion from paragraph (1) thereof of the amount "£2" (line 4), and the substitution therefor of the amount "£2. 18s. 0p.";

- (b) by the deletion from paragraph (2) thereof of the words and figures "not exceeding 50 gold francs (£2)" (line 4), and the substitution thereof of the words and figures "not exceeding 25 gold francs (£2. 18s. 0p.)".
3. These regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1951.
