- (b) by the deletion from paragraph (2) thereof of the words and figures "not exceeding 50 gold francs (£2)" (line 4), and the substitution therefor of the words and figures "not exceeding 25 gold francs (£2. 18s. op.)".
- 3. These regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1951.
