NOTIFICATION OF SANCTION OF THE ACQUISITION UNDER SECTION 6.

Whereas by a notification published under No. 27 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 7th February, 1946, the Acting Governor declared the acquisition of certain immovable properties in the Main State Forest of Ayia Erini, in the District of Kyrenia, to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, by notice published under No. 457 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st December, 1949, gave particulars of the immovable properties as aforesaid required in connection with the notification as aforesaid;

And whereas in compliance with the aforesaid Laws the Commissioner forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plans and particulars, together with the objections made;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plans and particulars submitted and considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances of the case, that the immovable properties in question be acquired:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated in the Main State Forest of Ayia Erini, in the District of Kyrenia, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the notice of the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia published under No. 457 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st December, 1949.
