A PROCLAMATION.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the villages of Layia and Vavla, in the District of Larnaca :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Sir Andrew Barkworth Wright, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross and Bar, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of April, 1950, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Layia in the District of Larnaca, shall form part of the lands of the village of Vavla in the District of Larnaca and that the boundaries of the said villages of Layia and Vavla shall be altered accordingly.

SCHEDULE.

Area to be transferred from Layia village to Vavla village :

The boundary commences at the north-western point of plot No. 243 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX.26, locality "Vounon", which point is on the boundary between the villages of Layia and Vavla, and proceeds south-eastwards and southwards along the said boundary to the south-eastern point of plot No. 306 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX.34, locality "Mazokambos", which point is on the carriage road leading from the village of Layia to the village of Vavla ; thence westwards along the said road to the south-western point of plot No. 311 of the said plan ; thence northwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 311, 253, 254, 255, 257, 258, 264, 265, 267, 268, 279, 277, 276, 275 and 274 of the said plan, plots Nos. 394, 389, 388, 386 and 243 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX.26 to the point of commencement.

All which said boundary of the said area is shown edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1457.
