## THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1950.

## BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF PAPHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1950, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Paphos hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to (No. 2) 1950 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Paphos Municipal Bye-laws, 1943 to 1951.

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2. Bye-law 26 of the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1948) is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion from paragraph (d) thereof of the figure and word "30th April" and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "31st March";

(b) by the deletion from paragraph (e) thereof of the figure and word "1st May" and the substitution therefor of the figure and word "1st April".

3. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 33 of the following bye-law :—

"33A. No person shall sell or expose for sale within the market of perishable goods any perishable goods which he has purchased within the said market, unless he first obtains a written permit from the Mayor."

4. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after bye-law 265 of the following Chapter and bye-law :—

*“ Chapter 4.—Hotels and Fees.*

266.—(1) Every licensee of an hotel of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd class shall pay to the town clerk and treasurer a fee of 2 piastres per night, and every licensee of an hotel of any other class a fee of 1 piastre per night, in respect of every person of over 10 years of age staying or residing at such hotel.

(2) The total amount of fees collected under this bye-law shall be paid to the town clerk and treasurer at the office of the Municipal Corporation at least once a week.

(3) Every licensee of an hotel shall keep a special register in which he shall enter (i) the name in full of each one of the visitors to such hotel, (ii) the age of such visitor, (iii) the time of the arrival of such visitor and (iv) the time of the departure of such visitor. The entries in the special register under (i), (ii) and (iii) shall be made as soon as the visitor enters the hotel and the entry under (iv) shall be made as soon as the visitor leaves the hotel.

(4) Every licensee of an hotel shall be bound to have the special register of the hotel at the disposal of the municipal employees during all reasonable times.

(5) At the written request of the Mayor any licensee of an hotel is bound within 24 hours from such request to have true copies of the special register of the hotel made and to supply same free of any charge to the Council or to any other person duly authorized in that behalf by the Mayor.”

5. Items 27 and 52 of the Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws (as set out in the Paphos Municipal (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1948) are hereby deleted and the following items substituted therefor, respectively :—

**THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 TO 1949.**

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 to 1949, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Evrykhon, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the *Gazette*.

**IRRIGATION DIVISION OF EVRYKHOV.**

*Rules.*

These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Evrykhon (Amendment) Rules, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Evrykhon Rules, 1936 and 1946 (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Rules ”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Evrykhon Rules, 1936 to 1951.

2. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word “ ten ” and the substitution therefor of the word “ thirty ”.
