SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 161. THE FOREST LAWS, 1939 AND 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2469

MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (2).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (2) of the Forest Laws, 1939 and 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minor State Forest (Pamboula Site) Order, 1951.

2. The area of land specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a Minor State Forest for the purposes of the Forest Laws, 1939 and 1948.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of land at the locality "Pamboula" in the town of Larnaca, being part of plot No. 368, Block H, Larnaca, shown on the Government Survey Plans Nos. XL.56.6.IV and XL.64.3.II and comprising 20 donums and 1 evlek approximately, more particularly defined as the area edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1498.

No. 162. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1950 and 1951.

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 9.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9 of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1951.

2. Without prejudice to the effect of any Order made by the Governor prior to the 30th January, 1951, and save as hereinafter otherwise provided, there shall vest in the Custodian—

- (a) the beneficial interest of any enemy or enemy subject in any property belonging to or held or managed on behalf of an enemy or an enemy subject on the 30th January, 1951, consisting of securities, or being property existing by virtue of any will, settlement, trust, intestacy or of any contract or agreement of any kind whatsoever;
- (b) without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing paragraph, the right to receive—
 - (i) any monies payable presently or at any future time in respect of any such property as aforesaid;
 - (ii) any dividends, bonus or interest payable presently or at any future time in respect of any such securities as aforesaid and in respect of any securities comprised in any Vesting Order made prior to the 30th January, 1951; and
 - (iii) any monies payable presently or at any future time in respect of any such securities as are mentioned in the last preceding sub-paragraph upon redemption or on maturity or upon such securities being drawn for payment or otherwise,
