No. 195. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

Whereas a scheme for the improvement of the water supply of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol and the acquisition of certain lands, trees, springs and water rights has been declared under Notification No. 127 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th March, 1951, to be an undertaking of public utility for the purposes of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947;

And whereas it has been represented to me that, for the purposes of the said scheme, it is desirable in the public interest that in addition to the springs and water rights known as "Mavromata" and "Kephalovryso" situated outside the limits of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol in the villages of Khalassa and Pano Kividhes, respectively, certain lands near or about the said springs should also be acquired;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, I, the Governor, do hereby declare the acquisition of the aforementioned additional lands to be an undertaking of public utility for the purposes of the aforesaid Laws and I do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and entrust the supervision and effectuation of such undertaking to the Municipal Corporation of Limassol.

2. This Notification is in addition to and shall be read together with Notification No. 127 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th March, 1951.
