THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAWS, 1949 TO 1951.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 19.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 19 of the Aliens and Immigration Laws, 1949 to 1951, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) Amendment Regulations, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) Regulations, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Aliens and Immigration (Registration of Aliens) Regulations, 1949 and 1951.
- 2. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation substituted therefor:—
 - "4. There shall be provided and maintained by every registration officer for his registration district a Register of Aliens in such form as may be approved by the Commissioner of Police."
- 3. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:— $\,$
 - (a) by the insertion in paragraph (1) thereof, immediately after sub-paragraph (k), of the following sub-paragraph:—
 - "(l) if a woman, who marries a British subject, forthwith report such marriage to a registration officer furnishing him at the same time with evidence, to his satisfaction, of the marriage and of the husband's nationality."
- 4. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation substituted therefor:—
 - "9. Every person shall furnish the registration officer with the name of every alien, who lodges with such person, not later than forty-eight hours after such alien has so lodged with such person:

Provided that nothing in this regulation shall apply to the keeper of a hotel, registered under the provisions of the Hotels Laws, who keeps a register under the said Laws."

- 5. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein, immediately after regulation 9, of the following regulation:—
 - "9A. Every person who takes into his service an alien, shall give notice to the registration officer as soon as such alien enters or leaves his service."
- 6. Paragraph (d) of regulation 13 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "or as entering the Colony for business" (lines 2 and 3).
- 7. The First Schedule and the Second Schedule to the principal Regulations are hereby revoked.
