## THE ALIENS AND IMMIGRATION LAWS, 1949 TO 1951.

## REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 19.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 19 of the Aliens and Immigration Laws, 1949 to 1951, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Aliens and Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Aliens and Immigration Regulations, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Aliens and Immigration Regulations, 1949 and 1951. *Gazette: Suppl. No 3: 16.6.1949*

2. Regulation 9 (6) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following proviso (the fullstop at the end thereof being replaced by a colon) :—

" Provided that, with regard to any Pupil's Permit or Visitor's Permit, the extension may be granted by an immigration officer."

3. Regulation 23 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following regulation substituted therefor :—

"Persons entering or leaving the Colony to answer questions, etc. 23. Every person entering or leaving the Colony—  
 (a) shall truthfully answer all questions put to him by the immigration officer at an approved port ; and  
 (b) shall, if required by the immigration officer—  
 (i) make and sign a statement in such form and containing such particulars as may be approved by the Chief Immigration Officer ;  
 (ii) submit himself for examination by a medical officer ;  
 (iii) produce to the immigration officer any documents (including any written or printed matter, plans, photographs and other pictorial representations) which are in his possession and which the immigration officer knows or has reason to believe contain evidence which will assist him to carry out his duties under the Law.

4. Regulation 27 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

5. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Forms 4, 5 and 6.
