LAW, 1948.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12 (2).

Notice is hereby given that the immovable property, as hereinafter, is required by the Water Commission of Bellapais in connection with a scheme for the supply and/or maintenance of a supply of water for the domestic purposes of the inhabitants of the said village under the provisions of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, 1948.
