## No. 200. THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW, 1934.

### NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Foreshore Protection Law, 1934, I do hereby give notice that :-

(1) except under a written permit from me and under such conditions as I may think fit to impose thereby, the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of foreshore described in the Schedule hereto, is absolutely prohibited;

(2) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto, is absolutely prohibited.

#### SCHEDULE.

The foreshore commences at the arkadji plot 49, Block C, Larnaca, locality "Kathari" (adjacent to and north of the oil storage tanks) and proceeds along the coast (for approximately 5 miles) to a point due south of the south-eastern corner of plot No. 193 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI/19 locality "Koukouphoudhia". This foreshore extends to a depth of 50 yards from high water mark throughout its length. The said foreshore is more particularly defined on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1501 a copy of which is available for inspection at the office of the Commissioner, Larnaca. (M.P. 1308/49.)

# No. 300. THE TREE PLANTING (VILLAGE AREAS) LAW, 1948.

#### ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 20.
