A PROCLAMATION.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Governor.

Whereas it is expedient for administrative purposes and otherwise to alter the District boundary between the District of Nicosia and the District of Limassol.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Administrative Divisions Law, 1878, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, the Governor, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of July, 1951, the District boundary between the District of Nicosia and the District of Limassol shall be altered so that the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore in the District of Nicosia, shall be reckoned and form part of the District of Limassol.

SCHEDULE.

Area to be transferred from Nicosia District to Limassol District.

The boundary commences at the point where the road from Prodhromos to Troodos is cut by the Nicosia–Limassol District boundary and proceeds south-eastwards along the north side of the said road to a point where it joins a track, locality "Xerolimni"; thence south-eastwards along the said track to the boundary stone No. S.A.6c.; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the boundary stone No. S.A.6D., situated near the Government triangulation point No. 1929/4, locality "Dhistraton Amiandou"; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the boundary stone No. S.A.7, at the junction of a stream with the stream from "Kannoures" spring, which point is on the Nicosia–Limassol District boundary ; thence south-eastwards and north-westwards along the said District boundary to the point of commencement, all which boundary of the said area is shown edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1489.
