THE CUSTOMS LAW.

CAP. 292.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2492

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 52 of the Customs Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Methyl Alcohol (Restriction) Order, 1951.

2. In this Order—

“ methyl alcohol ” includes wood naphtha, wood spirit and all other spirits of which the chief constituent is methyl alcohol.

3. The importation into the Colony of methyl alcohol is hereby prohibited save under a licence from the Comptroller, and subject to such conditions regarding its use and the time within which it shall be used as may be imposed by such licence.
