In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the British Nationality (Offences and Fees) Law, 1949, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) Amendment Regulations, 1951, and shall be read as one with the British Nationality (Fees) Regulations, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the British Nationality (Fees) Regulations, 1949 and 1951.

2. Paragraph (2) of regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "one pound" (line 2), and the substitution therefor of the words "two pounds".

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor:—
