And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia at the expiration of the period set out in the aforesaid notice forwarded to the Governor a plan of the immovable property together with particulars as regards its owner, description and estimated value, together with an objection made against the proposed acquisition ;

And whereas I have approved the plan submitted and I consider it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the Water Commission of Trapeza should be permitted to acquire the immovable property :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 (4) of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the immovable property. Cap. 311

No. 418. THE BURIALS LAW.

CAP. 53.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 18.

Whereas further use of the existing burial ground of the Orthodox-Christian community of Ayii Omoloyitadhes, in the District of Nicosia, is considered to be dangerous to the public health ;

And whereas the burial ground of Nicosia town is available for use by the inhabitants of Ayii Omoloyitadhes now included within the municipal limits :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 18 of the Burials Law and duly delegated to me under Notification No. 172, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I do hereby order that no burial shall take place in the burial ground of Ayii Omoloyitadhes in lieu whereof the burial ground of Nicosia town above referred to has been provided.
