## No. 428. THE ADULTERATION OF PRODUCE LAW.

### CAP. 34.

#### REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

J. FLETCHER-COOKE,  
*Acting Governor.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Adulteration of Produce Law, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:— Cap. 34

1. These regulations may be cited as the Adulteration of Produce (Dried Fruits) Regulations, 1951.

2. In these Regulations—

“Dried Fruits” means figs, raisins, currants, apricots, caisha, cherries, apples, plums and other fruit products dried either by sun’s heat or artificial heat.

3. Dried Fruits shall not contain any soil, stone, sand, straw or any other foreign substance, matter or thing whatsoever which does not normally exist in such fruits, and any Dried Fruits which do not comply with the above requirements shall, for the purposes of the Adulteration of Produce Law, Cap. 34 be deemed to be adulterated.

## No. 429.

### THE WATER SUPPLY (MUNICIPAL AND OTHER AREAS) LAW, 1951.

*Authority to the Nicosia Water Board to contract a loan.*

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Acting Governor has given his consent to the Water Board of Nicosia to borrow from the Loan Commissioners the sum of three hundred thousand pounds (£300,000) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions:—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Board to the Loan Commissioners in thirty equal annual instalments (comprising capital and interest);

(b) the sum borrowed shall be withdrawn in instalments in multiples of £1,000 and shall be utilized by the Board for general purposes connected with the Nicosia Water Supply Scheme including the purchase of pipes and equipment required by it.
