## NOTICE UNDER CLAUSE 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by clause 7 of the Supplies and Services (Motor Transport) (Operational Licensing) Orders, 1951, the Road Motor Transport Board hereby declare that—

- (a) from and after the 1st day of September, 1951, the road set out in the Schedule hereto shall be a controlled road within the meaning of clause 7 of the said Orders;

- (c) This notice is in addition to, and not in derogation of, the notice published under Notification No. 288 in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 30th May, 1951.
