LICENCE TO FISH FOR SPONGE WITH NAKED DIVERS AND HARPOON (KAMAKI).

OFFICE OF INSPECTOR OF FISHERIES.

..... of is hereby
 licensed to fish for sponge with naked divers and/or harpoon (kamaki) within the territorial waters
 of Cyprus, from until the 31st day of December, 19....., subject to the
 provisions of the Sponge Fishery Law and any order made thereunder and to the conditions
 hereinafter contained, that is to say :—

(a) the boat to be used by the licensee shall be seaworthy and well found in every
 particular, to the satisfaction of the Inspector of Fisheries.

(b) no trawling or scratching apparatus shall be used.

(c) no boat, when at sea, shall carry more than eight persons, excluding any apprentices as
 the Inspector of Fisheries may allow to accompany the boat under a written permit.

(d) no sponge of less than four inches or more than twelve inches in diameter shall be taken.

(e) all persons employed by the licensee in connection with sponge fishing shall be thoroughly
 trained in their respective duties.

(f) all sponges taken and landed shall be declared at the nearest Custom House, and the
 quantity and value shall be declared as taken under this licence.

(g) such deposit boats as the Inspector of Fisheries shall deem necessary shall be allowed
 free of licence duty.

FEES.

1. For each boat fitted with machine diving apparatus (crew not to exceed 30 persons)	£150
2. For each boat fitted with the " Fernez " diving apparatus only (crew not to exceed 15 persons)	£75
3. For each boat with naked divers and harpoon (kamaki) (crew not to exceed 8 persons)	£35
