THE POST OFFICE LAW. CAP. 281.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2510

MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Post Office Law, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1948 to 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1948 to (No. 2) 1951.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to:—

- (i) Great Britain and Northern Ireland; and
- (ii) Great Britain and Northern Ireland (Gift parcels) and the substitution therefor of the entry set out in the Schedule hereto.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1951.
