THE DANGEROUS DRUGS LAW.

CAP. 73.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2511 MADE UNDER SECTION 12 (2).

J. Fletcher-Cooke,

Acting Governor.

Whereas it appears to me that the drugs specified in the Schedule to this Order are productive, if improperly used, or are capable of being converted into a substance which is or is likely to be productive, if improperly used, of ill effects substantially of the same character or nature as or analogous to those produced by morphine or cocaine:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 (2) of the Dangerous Drugs Law, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order and declare as follows:—

- 1. Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Law shall apply to the drugs specified in the Schedule to this Order in the same manner as the said Part III applies to the drugs mentioned in section 12 (1) of the Dangerous Drugs Law.
- 2. This Order is in addition to and not in derogation of any other existing Order applying Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Law to any other drugs.

SCHEDULE.

1. Dihydrocodeine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of dihydrocodeine.

2. Acetyldihydrocodeine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of acetyldi-

hydrocodeine.

3. 4-Propionoxy-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 4-propionoxy-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine.

4. 3-Hydroxy-N-methylmorphinan, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-hydroxy-N-methylmorphinan.

No. 496. THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 92.

Notice under Section 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I do hereby absolutely prohibit—

- (a) The removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of foreshore described in the Schedule hereto.
- (b) The dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto.
