THE POST OFFICE LAW.

CAP. 281.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2512

MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Post Office Law I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1950 and 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1950 to (No. 2) 1951.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to Australia, France, Germany, Italy, New Zealand and the United States of America.

3. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein, in their respective alphabetical order, of the following entries:—
