THE COURTS OF JUSTICE (SUPPLEMENTARY No. 512, TO ME PROVISIONS) LAW.

CAP. 12.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 38.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 38 of the Courts of Justice (Supplementary Provisions) Law and with the advice and assistance of the Chief Justice, I, the Acting Governor, do hereby order as follows :-

2. This Order may be cited as the Companies (Court Fees) Order, 1951.

- 3. Save where otherwise provided for in any general rules made under the Companies Law, 1951, or otherwise, the fees set forth in the Appendix hereto shall be charged in respect of any proceedings in Court relating to Companies.
- 4. All fees payable under this Order shall be paid in stamps to be disposed of in the manner directed in each case.
- 5. A section referred to by number in the Appendix hereto means the section so numbered in the Companies Law, 1951.

APPENDIX.

1. On presenting a petition—

(a) under section 7 to confirm an alteration in a memorandum;

(b) under section 56 to confirm the reduction of a capital redemption reserve fund;

(c) under section 64 to confirm a reduction of capital; or

(d) under section 197 to sanction a compromise or scheme of arrangement.

Note.—Where a petition is presented under more than one of these sections, only one fee of £5 shall be charged on the petition.

- 2. On presenting a petition under section 326 to restore a name to the register of companies.
- On a certificate as to debts under section 7 or section 56 or section 64.
- 4. On presenting a petition for the winding up of a company by or under the supervision of the court.
 - Note.—No fee is payable on a winding-up order or an order continuing a voluntary liquidation subject to the supervision of the court.
- In any other proceeding or matter not otherwise provided for.
